My father is paralyzed, so when the war started and the evacuation continued, we, unfortunately, did not have the opportunity to leave, I could not leave my old parents... So, I, my seven-year-old daughter and my parents accepted a difficult decision to stay in Lysychansk.

I remember this day like today. My mother and I ventured outside to our garage. When we were returning home, I got distracted...a powerful explosion rang out. I realized later that I had stepped on a mine. My foot was torn off... Unfortunately, it all happened in front of my mother. At such moments, I am grateful to fate that I did not take my child, my Nastya, with me. I was evacuated by the military to the city of Kramatorsk, where I was operated on for the first time. I underwent the second operation already in Dnipro. Today I dream of only one thing - to see my daughter and parents who are under occupation. They are all I have...
